

106 food outlets, public toilets in Holland V certified clean & hygienic

SINGAPORE : All 106 food outlets and public toilets in Holland Village have been certified as being clean and hygienic under the Singapore's OK (SOK) programme run by the National Environment Agency (NEA).

It marks a key milestone for the Buona Vista's OK (BVOK) Programme that was launched in May this year.

The SOK campaign aims to promote the widespread adoption of good hygiene practices across Singapore.

Under the BVOK programme, some 30 grassroots volunteers from the Buona Vista Citizens' Consultative Committee have worked with the food establishments and toilets and conducted audits to ensure a high standard of hygiene.

The audits were carried out fortnightly and a total of 79 was conducted.

Mr Lim Swee Say, Minister in the Prime Minister's Office and Advisor to the Buona Vista Grassroots Organisation, said that the next step is to achieve SOK status for all the 198 food establishments and toilets in the Buona Vista Constituency within three months.

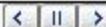
Since being relaunched, the SOK status has been awarded to 11,973 establishments.
