

# **Cordial, rolls may be cause of food poisoning in school**



CORDIAL drinks and chicken frank rolls were the suspects in a mass food poisoning incident at the Singapore Sports School on Nov 4, said the Ministry of Health, the National Environment Agency and the

Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority yesterday.

It was revealed that the cordial drinks served to students were prepared by ISS Catering Services at the school using a plastic bucket which was not clearly labelled. This, they said, can cause cross-contamination. The food handler from Wei Cian Foods, the chicken frank rolls manufacturer, was observed to handle ready-to-eat food with his bare hands, reported The Straits Times.
