\$9,000 fine for rojak seller



A relieved Sheik Allaudin Mohideen walked out of the Subordinate Courts yesterday after paying fines totalling \$9,000 for hygiene violations at his Indian rojak stall last year. The 70-year-old is hoping to get his licence back from the National Environment Agency, which had suspended him since the mass food poisoning outbreak in April last year. It left two women dead and sent 48 people to hospital. In all, more than 150 people fell ill after eating at his stall.
