

HFMD cases up but remain below warning level



THE number of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD) cases reached 509 last week, an increase of 38 from the week before, reported Channel NewsAsia.

And while this number is below warning levels, the Health Ministry said the public must remain vigilant.

The Carpe Diem Playskool at Yung Ho Road has been named on the MOH website as having an active cluster of more than 10 cases over 16 days.

MOH advises parents to ensure that their children wash their hands with soap before eating and after going to the toilet; and cover their mouths and noses when coughing or sneezing.
