

Holes in men's toilets bolted shut

HOLES in the partition wall in male toilets at Golden Mile Complex have been closed again.

Previously glued shut, the holes – believed to have been used by perverts for peeping or for sexual activity – were soon poked open.

Now, the holes – found on the second and third floors of the complex – have been bolted shut with wooden pieces.

The bolts have also been covered and levelled with wood filings.

The New Paper reported yesterday that at least one tenant of Golden Mile Complex no longer used the toilets because of the sleazy activities.

The man, who wanted to be known only as Mr Tan, said he was propositioned earlier this year while he was in one of the toilet cubicles.

He also told The New Paper that strange men would loiter in and around the male toilets in the complex.

Mr Tan said he was sexually harassed in the toilet early last year by a man, who even followed him when he quickly left.

Mr Tan now goes to the petrol kiosk about 100m away to use the washroom.

Other tenants whom The New Paper spoke to also said they did not walk around the complex unless necessary.

Internet videos have surfaced, apparently showing sex acts taking place in these

Golden Mile Complex and alleged that he had been groped in the toilet on the third storey, also expressed relief.

She said: "I'm relieved that the holes are gone. Maybe now the place will be less sleazy and dangerous."

It is not clear who covered the holes after we ran our report on it yesterday.

Said Mr Tan: "When I went to the toilet this morning, the holes were still there."

"But when I went again in the afternoon, pieces of wooden boards had been used to block the holes."
