South West CDC is taking public cleanliness to a new level.

It is giving out three public health awards.

One of them is the "Clean, Dry and Sparkling Toilet Award".

It is to fulfil one of its public health goals set last year - which is to heighten public health awareness and enhance environmental standards in the district.

Constituents of the South West district had picked eight toilets for the "Clean, Dry and Sparkling Toilet Award".

Now the judges have to look for the best.

The judging criteria are the toilet's cleanliness, ventilation and the presence of a cleaner during peak hours.

Bonus points are also given for user-friendly toilets with good designs.

South West CDC hopes this award might be a precursor to a national-level award for best toilet.

Dr Amy Khor, Mayor of South West District, said: "If we want to be a world-class city, if we want to be a nation that has got very good standards of public hygiene and cleanliness, the best place to start with is the public toilet."

"We would like to promote it as an annual event, because that will encourage more people to take part," she added.

The other two awards given out are the "Litter-Free Environment" award and the "Community that Does Not Spread Bugs" award. - CNA/ir
