RESTROOM ASSOCIATION (SINGAPORE) LAUNCHES COMPREHENSIVE HYGIENE CHECKLISTS & GRANT FOR PRESCHOOLS

The launch is a joint effort between the association and APP Commercial Pte Ltd (APP) to promote good hygiene practices in preschools

1. At the APP-RAS LOO (Let's Observe Ourselves) Awards ceremony jointly organised by APP Commercial Pte Ltd (APP), the manufacturer of premium tissues PASEO and LIVI, and the Restroom Association (Singapore), a set of hygiene checklists (**Annex A**) and a new Happy Toilets @ Preschools Projects (HTPP) Grant were launched to commemorate World Toilet Day.
2. The checklists were developed mostly based on recommendations provided by reliable sources such as the latest 2019 edition Infection Prevention Guidelines for Primary Schools and Child Care Centres and the Sanitation and Hygiene Advisory for Preschools jointly issued by the Early Childhood Development Agency and the National Environment Agency. Preschools can download the checklists from the RAS website at www.toilet.org.sg and preschools can also write to RAS at info@toilet.org.sg to request for training on the checklists.
3. The set of 10 hygiene checklists covers the entire preschool environment and targets the four target groups namely children, teachers, cleaning and kitchen staff. Children and teachers will each have one checklist while kitchen staff will have two checklists. The remaining six checklists are for cleaning staff to perform cleaning tasks at entrances, offices, classrooms, communal rooms, infant/toddler care rooms and toilets.
4. The HTPP Grant, capped at \$200 per preschool, will open for application from now till 31 March next year. A maximum of 20 preschools participating in the Happy Toilets @ Preschools Programme (**Annex B**) can tap on the grant to embark on projects namely decoration, inspection, exhibition and appreciation (showing kindness to cleaning and kitchen staff). Training will be conducted for teachers of participating preschools to equip them with the knowledge and resources to guide their children from N1 to K2 (4 to 6 years), to execute the projects. Interested preschools can apply for the grant from RAS website.
5. RAS President Mr Ho Chee Kit said, "Since 2015, we have been actively reaching out to more than 100 preschools under our Happy Toilets @ Preschools Programme, to educate

children, teachers and support staff on good hygiene practices. With the current situation, it is timely for us to launch these checklists to encourage all preschools to adopt good hygiene practices. With the concurrent introduction of the Happy Toilets @ Preschools Projects Grant, we hope preschools can take ownership of educating the children through hygiene-related projects and activities.”

6. Ms Christina Lye, Country Head APP Commercial Pte Ltd said, “We are pleased to partner with RAS to support this initiative for preschools. It is never too early to inculcate hygiene education and conscious graciousness towards service providers. We look forward to seeing the creative ideas from the preschools on how they would like to use the grant to guide the young children and create a safer and more gracious preschool environment for everyone.”

7. Due to safe management measures, the award ceremony lasts about three hours and a congratulatory video message from Senior Minister of State for Sustainability and the Environment Dr Amy Khor is extended to 51 award recipients (**Annex C**). Both Mr Ho and Ms Lye jointly present the APP-RAS LOO Awards to the recipients including preschools which are awarded the Platinum award for receiving their Happy Toilets @ Preschool Programme certification for three consecutive years.












About World Toilet Day

ANNEX B

HAPPY TOILETS @ PRESCHOOLS PROGRAMME

Introduction

The Happy Toilets @ Preschools Programme (HTPP) was launched by then Parliamentary Secretary for Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) Ms Low Yen Ling on 3 February 2015. It is a holistic programme, renewable annually, aims at encouraging preschools to achieve the highest accreditation of completing the three phases on Design, Maintenance and Education within a six-month period. To encourage and recognise sustained achievement, preschools will be accredited with the Platinum Award if they achieve the highest accreditation for three consecutive years.

Grading System

To resonate better with parents, teachers and preschoolers, a simple grading system will be employed for preschools participating in the programme.

A plaque with the Happy Toilet logo will be presented to each preschool upon completion of the three phases of the Happy Toilet @ Preschool Programme. The three phases are:

1. Design phase
All toilets meeting the minimum standard equivalent to the 3-star rating of the commercial Happy Toilet Programme.
2. Maintenance phase
On-site training for caretakers and housekeepers on dos and don'ts of preschool and toilet cleaning
3. Education phase
Hygiene talks/activities for preschoolers and hygiene workshops for teachers or hygiene talks for parents/guardians

A 'thumbs up' icon will be displayed to determine the completion of a phase of the Happy Toilets @ Preschool programme.



ANNEX C
